- *What is Family Fun Xperience?*
 - Family Fun Xperience (or FFX) is a brand new interactive production for families at the Oceanfront resort area in Virginia Beach.
- *What roles are being cast?*
 - We are casting all roles – Mom and Dad (ages 30-40), High School Daughter (played by an adult), Elementary-aged Son (played by an adult), a Grandpa, and Ushers (2).
 - Due to the ongoing show schedule all 7 acting roles will be cast deep, with multiple cast members able to play one or possibly multiple roles.
- *Why would I need to audition to be an usher?*
 - Our ushers serve multiple roles – while not only helping the audience, the ushers are instrumental with our game, play minor roles throughout the show, and also are studying/playing one or more of the family characters.
- *What do I need to include in my video submission?*
 - Please start by introducing yourself, plus tell us a fun story about growing up in your family.
 - Present 2 one-minute monologues – 1 comedic and 1 dramatic. Both monologues should be clean and family-friendly.
- *Who should I send my video to?*
 - Please email all submissions to careers@ffxshow.org
 - Include a copy of your headshot with your resume.
- *What if I am more interested in technical or front of house positions?*
 - Please email your resume and positions you are interested in: careers@ffxshow.org
- *When will I hear back about a callback or interview?*
 - Callbacks consist of being invited to a group callback or an ongoing rehearsal (we are always adding cast members and rehearsing new bits and games for this year-round production).
 - If you are invited back for a third time, you are considered part of the company and we will begin integrating you into the show in a paid role.
 - If you inquire about a technical or front of house position, we will set up a meeting with you.
- *What about COVID-19?*
 - Our theater is set up for social distancing and other precautions and modifications have been taken into account for the space and for the performance, for the protection of cast, crew, and patrons. We are following current Virginia requirements, CDC recommendations, and other industry practices including wearing of face masks, sanitizing of microphones, temperature checks, etc. If you forget your mask, we have some disposable masks available.
- *Is this just a game?*
 - We are the play that people get to play along with, but we are serious about having some great local talent onstage for our locals and tourist seasons. We are a 501c3 nonprofit, but these are paid regular positions, and with the opportunity to make a greater impact on families. You've read everything above, now it's your turn to show us what you've got!
